上帝与我们同受苦 God Suffers with Us

耶利米书 Jeremiah 9:1-9 李万兵 Wanbing Frank Li, PhD

Suffering is one of the frequently discussed topics in life. Whenever a tragedy strikes such as the bombing in Brussels or Tsunami in Japan, people often ask questions such as, "Why does an omnipotent and merciful God let people suffer? Does the almighty God have the power to stop the sufferings of the people? Does the merciful God care to do anything to stop sufferings of people?"

Some people may reason this way: If God is not able to stop suffering, He is not omnipotent. And if He does not care to stop suffering, He is not merciful. Therefore, some of them believe the existence of suffering in the world indicate that God is either impotent or not merciful. God cannot be both omnipotent and merciful. In other words, the suffering in the world may imply that an omnipotent and merciful God does not exist.

怜悯与苦难

先知耶利米蒙召预告上帝 的审判和谴责罪恶,对于犹 大和耶路撒冷即将面临的灾 难,耶利米表现出极大的悲 痛。

"但愿我的头为水,我的 眼为泪的泉源,我好为我百 姓(原文作"民女")中被 杀的人,昼夜哭泣。"(耶利 米书9:1)

耶利米表达的是上帝的心, 祂与祂的子民同受苦难, 因为祂富有怜悯慈爱, 祂爱惜祂的子民, 并不高兴看到他们受苦。

圣洁的上帝与罪人

但同时, 因为上帝是圣洁

It sounds reasonable to our human understanding, doesn't it? But human beings have limited understanding of God. Sufferings may be from various different sources, such as natural disasters, human mistakes, punishments of human sins, etc. God may teach His children lessons through disciplining punishments and sufferings.

God is the creator of all of us humans, and He has a higher purpose for his children than just a comfortable life on this earth. He wants to develop our characters through sufferings, and he suffers with us when we suffer, as recorded in Jeremiah 9.

Merciful vs. Suffering

Being Commissioned to foretell God's judgement and reprove sins, Prophet Jeremiah expressed great sorrow with the miseries of Judah and Jerusalem.

Oh that my head were waters, and my eyes a fountain of tears, that I might weep day and night for the slain of the daughter of my people! (Jeremiah 9:1)

What Jeremiah expressed was the heart of God who suffers with His people because He is merciful, and loves His people. He does not delight to see their sufferings.

Holy God and Sinners

But at the same, because God is holy and does not tolerate sins. He wants to get away from sinners as sinners would not be able stand 的, 祂不能容忍罪过。祂希 望离开罪人, 因为罪人不能 在祂面前站立。

祂极爱我们,不希望我们 永远生活在罪恶里面。祂会 惩罚我们的罪过,让我们回 到祂的面前:

所以万军之耶和华如此说:"看哪!我要将他们熔化熬炼。不然,我因我百姓[的罪]该怎样行呢?"(耶利米书9:7)

公义与罪恶

我们的罪恶应当受到祂的 惩罚,因祂是公义的上帝。

"他们的舌头是毒箭,说话诡诈,人与邻舍口说和平话,心却谋害他。耶和华说:我岂不因这些事讨他们

before Him.

Oh that I had in the desert a travelers' lodging place, that I might leave my people and go away from them! For they are all adulterers, a company of treacherous men. They bend their tongue like a bow; falsehood and not truth has grown strong in the land; for they proceed from evil to evil, and they do not know me, declares the LORD. (Jeremiah 9:2-3)

Some people believe that God loves us so much that He should accept us no matter what we do. The fact is that He hates sins, and consequently He separates Himself from sinners. We may be making a serious mistake if we believe that God loves us so much that He will turn a blind eye about our sins.

He loves us so much that He does not want us to live with our sins forever. He will punish our sins in order to get us back to Him:

Therefore thus says the LORD of hosts: "Behold, I will refine them and test them, for what else can I do, because of my people?" (Jeremiah 9:7)

Righteous vs. Sinful

Our sins deserve His punishments because He is a righteous God.

Their tongue is a deadly arrow; it speaks deceitfully; with his mouth each speaks peace to his neighbor, but in his heart he plans an ambush for him. Shall I not punish them for these things? declares the LORD,

成为基督徒不是让我们有自由犯罪。相反,基督的圣灵来住在我们里面,我们跟随上帝的灵的带领,就有自由不再犯罪。感谢赞美那全知全能又富有怜悯慈爱的雅威上帝。

and shall I not avenge myself on a nation such as this? (Jeremiah 9:8-9)

Because our Yahweh God is a righteous God, He does punish all sins. He is a holy God, and He cannot be with sins and sinful people. However, God loves us so much that He even sent His only Son Jesus Christ to die for our sins, so that we may receive the gift of salvation when we accept Christ as our Savior and Lord. The cross of Jesus Christ shows that the omnipotent Yahweh suffered with us and for us. He lets His only Son die for our sins because He is a merciful God: His Son Jesus Christ had to die for our sins because He is a righteous God. The judgments our sins are on Jesus. Yahweh God is so mighty that He let Jesus Christ resurrected from death. Therefore, the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ show that our God is a merciful, righteous and omnipotent God.

Becoming Christians does not grant us the freedom to sin. Instead the Holy Spirit of Christ comes to dwell within us so that we may have the freedom not to sin when we follow the guidance of the Spirit of God. Thanks and praise to the omnipotent and merciful Yahweh God.
